

BROTHER PAULUS MORITZ

FOUNDER OF THE FRANCISCAN MISSIONARY BROTHERS

Being inspired by the MISSION of Saint Francis of Assisi, Brother PAULUS MORITZ left his motherland, Germany and came to India in 1895 to spread the message of BROTHERHOOD and PEACE among the people. He founded the Congregation of the Missionary Brothers of Saint Francis of Assisi in 1901 in India.

He began his MISSION taking care of 16 orphan children in Mount Poincur in 1908. Today 120 years after his death, the Congregation he founded remains as dedicated as ever to advancing the cause of WORLD PEACE, through works of compassion, education and love.

St. Francis School is a co-educational institution and admission is open to children of all communities irrespective of caste, creed, religion or region.

The School has an impressive campus with essential amenities required for all round development of the students. It is spread over 10 acres of land with a spacious play ground.

St. Francis Group of Institutions are spread across the world Germany, Italy, Switzerland, North America, Canada, Paraguay, Bolivia, Srilanka, Africa and in almost all the states in India.

CLASS ROOMS

 - ♦ The above Documents will be asked to be submitted to the School Office only after the Results of the Entrance Examination

SAINT FRANCIS OF ASSISI

PATRON OF ST. FRANCIS SCHOOL

Saint Francis of Assisi was born at Assisi, Italy in 1182. He grew up leading a privileged life as the son of a wealthy cloth merchant. As a young boy, he abandoned a life of luxury and wealth for a life entirely devoted to God and the poor after reportedly hearing the voice of God, who commanded him to rebuild the Church and live in poverty.

Saint Francis was a man of peace. In everything he did, he constantly sought to create peace, dialogue and harmony between people, families, and nations. "*Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God*". The Lord revealed to Saint Francis of Assisi, a greeting, and we are greeted with the same greeting as we enter the threshold of our School Gate, "MAY THE LORD GIVE YOU PEACE". Francis of Assisi died on October 3, 1226, at the age of 44, in Assisi, Italy. The Feast Day of Saint Francis of Assisi is celebrated on October 4th every year and the same day is PEACE DAY for St. Francis Family of Schools throughout the world.
